

NAG visit to PARIS June 2022

Covid international travel arrangements have improved and NAG is organising a 4-day visit to Naurist Paris. This will be **Friday 24 – Monday 27 June**, during which we will join with our naturist friends in ANP (Association des Naturistes de Paris) and in APNEL (Association for free naturism). We expect to visit the Friday evening naturist swim at Piscine Roger le Galle, the Saturday evening naturist swim at Piscine Georges Rigal and the Sunday large picnic at Espace Naturisme in Bois de Vincennes. Please note that there is 1km walk to get to the picnic area from the Metro. We welcome naturists of both sexes for this Paris visit.

As a capital city Paris is not a cheap destination. **Figures quoted here are a guide only!** Costs for those travelling from London on Eurostar, 3-nights B+B hotel near Gare du Nord, plus a Travel card for bus/Metro/RER for this period, would possibly total £350. You could also travel by other means and from your own starting point and date. We will arrange a meet-up place in Paris. Each person will cover their own costs and, unless you want to stay longer, travel back to the UK would be during Monday.

Enjoying Paris

We will not go for expensive meals and there are plenty of bars at reasonable prices. One lunch will be in a bistro at Place du Tertre by the iconic Sacre Cour white domed church. There will also be periods for sightseeing. Admission charges for the City Sightseeing Bus, Batobus on the Seine, and any attractions would be additional, according to personal choice. Long queues build at the Louvre. If this is an essential part of the visit for you then plenty of time should be planned. Other museums may not be open on Monday.

Requirements for travelling to France

A UK covid vaccination record document and a French vaccination pass are required. Fuller details are available online. **If you have not been covid vaccinated, then you will have great difficulty in getting entry to France.** You will need to have a Passport with at least 3 months extra time after this visit on it. You **must** have an insurance certificate which meets the French government requirements.

Taking this forward

Then the travel needs to be booked, fairly soon, and thirdly, book a hotel in the vicinity of Gare du Nord.
